

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are the proven way to motivate and enthuse individuals by providing them with industry skills and knowledge required in this ever changing economy.

An Apprenticeship is broken into three sections: NVQ, Functional Skills (formerly known as Key Skills) and Employers Rights & Responsibilities (ERR).

The NVQ is the industry qualification, consisting of both practical and theory training. Functional Skills consist of English, Maths and ICT. Employers Rights and Responsibilities covers Employment Acts from Working Time Regulations to Maternity & Paternity Leave.

Upon completion of all three sections above, the learner has achieved a Full Apprenticeship Framework.
